Please remember, if you are going south for the winter, you have two (2) options for your utility bill. If you do not wish to receive a bill, you may have your meter pulled and you will need to drain your lines. There is a \$25.00 reconnection fee when you have your meter put back in. If you do not want to pull your meter, you may leave your water on and stop your garbage, if you are going to be gone for more than two (2) consecutive months.
