Garage Sale Ordinance

We would like to remind people, if you are having a garage sale, City Ordinance states the following:

- Such sale shall be held on premises owned or leased by at least one sale participant.
- Such sale shall not last for more than three (3) consecutive days at any one location.
- There shall be a two (2) week period between garage sales/rummage sales/yard sales at any one location.
- Sale items and tables shall be enclosed in a building from sunset to sunrise.
- A violation of this section is a simple misdemeanor or municipal infraction as set out in the City Code.

★ **Food Court (NEW):** Our food court offers a nice variety for everyone! Seating will be available under the big tent at the entrance to the grounds. The food court (of which the proceeds help pay for the fireworks) opens at 5:30pm featuring Pizza Ranch (pizza and cactus bread), Hy-Vee (Burger Barn, walking tacos, watermelon & cookies) and Kelly's Catering (BBQ pork sandwiches, chicken strips, baked beans, coleslaw and chips). All other attractions begin at 6:00pm.

Hydration Stations (NEW): There will be two Hydration Stations – one located in the Food Court and one in the Carnival Booth area for your convenience. We will offer bottled water, Mountain Dew, Diet Mountain Dew, Coke, Diet Coke, Sprite Zero and Lemonade.

Kettle Corn: If you've ever had kettle corn, you know why we're excited. If you haven't experienced the taste sensation in the past, you will have something to look forward to!

Entertainment: Starting at 6pm, the Village will be hosting a qualifying event for Bill Riley Talent Search Contest. People from various age groups will be competing to qualify and the winners from each category will advance to the Bill Riley Talent Search Contest at the Iowa State Fair. Following our local entertainment, student teams will compete in a Village Fear Factor competition.

Children's Carnival Booths: There's sure to be fun and excitement for kids of all ages with the carnival booths, set up east of the Wansink Center. Booths include the duck pond, bean bag toss, face painting, fishing pond, limbo, dart throw, plinko, dunk tank (NEW), etc.

Fire Truck Rides: The Sheldon Fire Department will again offer rides on three trucks around Village Circle. Board trucks on south side of Wansink Center.

Petting Zoo: A variety of animals will be on hand and waiting to receive your love and attention, just northeast of Wansink Center. All ages enjoy these little critters.

Horse Drawn Wagon Rides: Enjoy the scenic ride through the Village's nature trail via one of 4 horse drawn wagons, boarding northeast of the Wansink Center.

Kiddie Train Rides & Ferris Wheel: FUN for the young ones...they'll want several rides. Two trains will be located south of the Wansink Center garage area, with the ferris wheel close by.

Water Wars: Fun for all ages...get set to get wet as you catapult water balloons at your opponent.

Bungee Run & Velcro Wall (NEW): Fun for all ages...race your friends with the Bungee Run (best 2 out of 3 wins!) and try out the Velcro Wall (3 tries allows you to be creative with your 'landing'!)

Balloon Artist/Magician: Ricky Rowray, will be in the Wansink Center commons creating balloon animals, etc. for the kids. Also check out the Village booth in the commons - featuring items from Fantasia & What A Stitch. They'll be selling embroidered items, A-Cut-Above notepads, woven items, & more.

Ice Cream Parlor: Located in the Wansink Center gym, soda jerks will be serving ice cream and you can add your favorite sundae toppings. Relax at tables & chairs in the air conditioned gym while you enjoy your treat.

Fireworks: Sheldon Fire Department members will be shooting off the gigantic fireworks display that will conclude the evening's activities, launched in the Sunrise Park area, near the entrance to the Village.

Cost: The fun & entertainment are FREE, with the exception of the food, kiddie train rides, water wars, ferris wheel, Velcro wall, Bungee Run, dunk tank and carnival booths.
