## Recreation Information

- The Recreation Department is now registering for the 2013 Indoor Soccer League for Grades TK-6. The registration deadline is February 6, 2013. Late fees will be enforced after the deadline. The League will start on Saturday, February 23 and will meet every Saturday, culminating on Saturday, March 30. The league will have a TK-Kindergarten division, 1st-2nd grade division, 3rd-4th grade division and a 5th-6th grade division, all of which are co-ed. This league is a recreational league whose primary goal is to provide a fun and safer environment in which the soccer players can develop and refine their skills. Emphasis is placed on FUNDamental soccer skills, sportsmanship and team play. The registration fee is \$30, with a \$10 discount if a parent volunteers to coach, and a \$10 discount if a jersey is not needed.
- The Recreation Department is now taking applications for lifeguards, concession workers, ball coaches, ball umpires and recreation program assistants. Application deadline is April 1, 2013. The three issues on the ballot include:

- Vote to increase the last three years of current PPEL Levy to \$1.34/\$1,000 taxable valuation
- Vote to add an additional 10 year PPEL Levy at \$1.34/\$1,000 taxable valuation
- Vote on a Local Option Sales Tax Revenue Purpose Statement

All three ballot issues must receive a **50% + 1** for passage.


