

SHOP WITH A COP

The Sheldon Police Department is asking for free will donations from businesses and residents of the Sheldon community to help with a program called "Shop with a Cop" that helps buy clothing for children with the greatest need in our community. This year we will be partnering with Love Inc. for this program, and Love Inc. will select the families with the greatest need to participate in the event. Each child will be paired with a volunteer and will be taken to Shopko, where they will be allowed to purchase clothing, shoes, and other "back to school" items. Last year the program was able to help 51 children in the community and, due to the unsettled times with the economy, we expect the number of families to grow this year. Any amount will be greatly appreciated. If someone would like to make a donation, cash or a check is acceptable. If by check, please make payable to "Shop with a Cop" and either drop off the check or cash at the Sheldon Police Department or the Sheldon City Office, and let them know that it is for this community project. All donations need to be received by June 15th, 2013 so we have enough time to select the recipients and line up the volunteers.

SPRING CLEAN UP COMING—FLAGS ON SALE APRIL 1

West of Washington Avenue is April 29 & April 30

East of Washington Avenue is May 6 & 7

If you would like to participate, a \$15.00 fee must be paid at the City Clerk's Office, 416 9th Street by **April 26th at 3:00 p.m. if you live on the West side of Washington Avenue, and May 3rd at 3:00 p.m. if you live on the East side of Washington Avenue.** Upon payment, you will receive a flag that must be prominently displayed at your residence with your items to be picked up. No payments will be accepted at the time of pick up.

- 1. ITEMS MUST BE PLACED CURB SIDE;** no items will be picked up on the alleys. After the city crew goes past your house on Tuesday, you will not be allowed to deposit more items.
- 2. METAL AND APPLIANCES SHOULD NOT BE PLACED IN THE TRASH PILE.** These will be picked up separately, and must be on a separate pile.
- 3. APPLIANCES WITH COMPRESSORS** will be picked up if the freon has been removed by a certified technician, and a tag has been placed by the technician indicating this has been done. **ALL ITEMS WITH CAPACITORS** must have them removed before we will pick them up. **THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.**
- 4. TREE BRANCHES OR BRUSH WILL BE PICKED UP SEPARATELY,** and must be piled separately. We will not pick up commercially cut trees and brush.
- 5. RESIDENTIAL HOMES ONLY.** Mobile Homes & Apartments may be picked up on an individual basis. No businesses will be picked up.
- 6. PLEASE, ONE HOUSEHOLD PER FLAG.**

*******ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP*******

HAZARDOUS, TOXIC MATERIALS, OR LIQUIDS of any kind. State guidelines classify batteries, paint, thinner, stains, gas, oil, insecticides, pesticides, etc. as hazardous or toxic waste.

TIRES OR BATTERIES

ROOFING OR LARGE PILES OF DEMOLITION MATERIAL

GARBAGE

GRASS TRIMMINGS OR LEAVES

CONCRETE OR BRICK

No containers will be left. Please do not use good garbage cans or recycling bins.

NEW ZONING PERMIT FEES

It has been several years since the City of Sheldon has updated the fees for issuing zoning permits. Below, please find listed the updated fees for a permit within the City of Sheldon city limits. No structures, buildings, or parts thereof shall be erected, constructed, reconstructed, remodeled, converted, altered, enlarged, extended, raised, moved or used and no land shall be used except in conformity with the regulations for various districts as allowed in the City of Sheldon Zoning Code and without a proper Zoning Permit.

Fees effective March 1, 2013:

Residential	\$25.00-fence, deck, accessory Bldg, etc \$50.00-garage/room addition, etc \$150.00-maximum on a new dwelling
Commercial	\$60.00-garage, fence, accessory building \$200.00-maximum for principal building
Industrial	\$75.00-garage, fence or accessory building \$300.00-maximum principal building

Zoning Variance Application—\$125.00 plus all costs associated.
Rezoning Application—\$125.00 plus all costs associated.
Sign Permit—\$35.00
