The Sheldon Police Department wishes to remind motorists that beginning on November 1st, the Overnight Parking Ban on the city streets goes into effect. Motorists are not allowed to park their vehicles on any street in Sheldon between the hours of 2 a.m. and 6 a.m. from November 1st until April 1st. Motorsits are also reminded that the fine amount for these violations is \$10. Residents are encouraged to remind all of their overnight guests of this Ordinance.

Please remember, your utility account number is required for any changes to your utility account. If you are going south for the winter, you have two (2) options for your utility bill. If you do not wish to receive a bill, you may have your meter pulled and you will need to drain your lines, There is a \$25.00 reconnection fee when you return and have your water hooked back up. If you do not want to pull your meter, you may leave your water on and stop your garbage, if your are going to be gone for more than two (2) months.
