SUMMER RECREATION REGISTRATION—OPEN!


The Sheldon Parks & Recreation registration is now open! Residents can access the service at the City's website, www.sheldoniowa.com, under City Services, Parks & Recreation Page. People will be able to register online or by coming into the City Offices. Walk in registrations will be charged a \$2 front desk fee per child, with a maximum of \$6 per family. The brochure was distributed through the schools in Sheldon, as well as our email distribution list. You can also pick one up in the City Office.

Please notice that the registration deadline for Baseball and Softball is April 18, 2014. All other registration deadlines are May 9, 2014. Garage, Rummage or Yard Sales

We would like to take this time to remind people of the Ordinance pertaining to garages sales, rummage sales and yard sales.

- Such sale shall be held on premises owned or leased by at least one sale participant.
- Such sale shall not last for more than three (3) consecutive days at any one location. There shall be a two (2) week period between garage sales/rummage sales/yard sales at any one location.
- Sale items and tables shall be enclosed in a building from sunset to sunrise.
- A violation of this section is a simple misdemeanor or municipal infraction as set out in Section 1.10 or Chapter 4 of the City Code.

FEE: \$15.00— Upon payment, you will receive a flag that must be prominently displayed at your residence with your items to be picked up.

Electronics and Appliances are an additional \$5 per item. Upon payment, you will receive a sticker for each item, which needs to be placed in a highly visible area. (Electronics and Appliances are described as: Air Conditioners, Clothes Dryer, Clothes Washer, Dehumidifier, Freezer, Furnace, Stove, Microwave, Dishwasher, Refrigerator, Water Heater, Computer, Monitor, Tower, Printer, Television, Copier). Items with Compressors or Freon, please see rule #3.

No payments will be accepted at the time of pick up.

DEADLINES:

West side of Washington Avenue: April 25th at 3:00 p.m.

East side of Washington Avenue: May 2rd at 3:00 p.m.

- 1. ITEMS MUST BE PLACED CURB SIDE by 7:00 a.m. Monday morning;** no items will be picked up on the alleys. After the city crew goes past your house, you will not be allowed to deposit more items. Trees/brush and appliances/electronics may be picked up separately.
- 2. METAL AND APPLIANCES SHOULD NOT BE PLACED IN THE TRASH PILE.** These will be picked up separately, and must be on a separate pile.
- 3. APPLIANCES WITH COMPRESSORS** will be picked up if the freon has been removed by a certified technician, and a tag has been placed by the technician indicating this has been done. **ALL ITEMS WITH CAPACITORS** must have them removed before we will pick them up. **THIS WILL BE ENFORCED.**
- 4. TREE BRANCHES OR BRUSH WILL BE PICKED UP SEPARATELY,** and must be piled separately. We will not pick up commercially cut trees and brush.
- 5. RESIDENTIAL HOMES ONLY.** Mobile Homes & Apartments may be picked up on an individual basis. No businesses will be picked up.
- 6. PLEASE, ONE HOUSEHOLD PER FLAG.**

*******ITEMS THAT WILL NOT BE PICKED UP*******

- **HAZARDOUS, TOXIC MATERIALS, OR LIQUIDS** of any kind. State guidelines classify batteries, paint, thinner, stains, gas, oil, insecticides, pesticides, etc. as hazardous or toxic waste.
- **TIRES OR BATTERIES**
- **ROOFING OR LARGE PILES OF DEMOLITION MATERIAL.**
- **GARBAGE**
- **GRASS TRIMMINGS OR LEAVES**
- **CONCRETE OR BRICK**

No containers will be left. Please do not use good garbage cans or recycling bins.
