HOW TO REGISTER:

- The first things you need to do are print or browse the Shortcut Schedule (on page 9 of this document). This will be your best friend during this registration process. Once you have that in front of you please continue on.
- Register online at www.sheldoniowa.com. Scroll down on the home page and Click on the Sheldon Recreation Logo. This will bring you to our Active Net site where you can register your child and pay online from the comfort of your home. If you have already used this system, just login using your account information. If you are new to the system you will have to create an account. Click on "City Services" > "City Departments" > "Parks and Rec."
- You can search for a program by typing in the program name.
- Walk-in registration is also available at the City Office from 7:30am-4:00pm Monday – Friday. Our Office address is 416 9th St, located in the Community Building Downtown. All walk-in registrations will be charged a \$2.00 registration fee per child with a maximum of \$6.00 per family.
- Pay close attention to the registration deadlines above as late fees will be assessed to late registrations. On-time registration is very important for uniform orders as well as accurate program rosters and team schedules. Late registrations are not guaranteed a requested uniform size or entrance into the program.

PARENTS NIGHT:

- On July 12 at 6:00pm we will be hosting a Parent's Night at the High School for the participants in Cheer & Drill Team and Children's Theatre. Many more details on this event to follow. This will give our participants in these programs an opportunity to show the community what they have been working on during the 6 week program. Mark your calendars; this will be an exciting night and a great close to our summer recreation season!!

CHILDREN'S WORLD

- If your child attends Children's World, staff will be available to provide drop-off and pick-up from select approved activities within walking distance of the center.
- Approval from Children's World must be in place at least two weeks prior to the activity start date.

PROGRAM COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Indoor Activities

Beginner Tumbling

This program will be held at the Sheldon E. Elementary School Cafeteria. Children in grades 1st-3rd will learn basic tumbling skills, and progressive tumbling skills. Some examples of skills taught are Forward Rolls, Backward Rolls, Handstands, Cartwheels, Round-offs, and are introduced to Back Handspring techniques. Please refer to the activity schedule for class times and options.

Activity Cost: \$30

Need 5 or more participants per class.

Cheer/Drill Team

This program will be held at the High School Gymnasium. Participants will learn numerous cheers and a drill team performance as well as introducing Tumbling. The Cheer/Drill team will learn a routine to perform on Parent's Night on July 12. Open to kids currently enrolled in 2-6. Please refer to the activity schedule for class times and options.

Activity Cost: \$30

Need 5 or more participants per class time

Children's Theatre

This program will be held in the High School Choir Room. This program will allow participants to engage in theater games and drama activities. The kids will also be assigned a role in a play that will be presented at Parent's Night on July 12. Open to kids currently enrolled in 2-6. Please refer to the activity schedule for class times and options.

Activity Cost: \$30

Volleyball

This program will be held at the Sheldon East Elementary Gym. Kids will be able to learn and refine the basic volleyball skills that they can carry over to our fall recreation program. **3rd-4th Grade practices will be held on Monday & will have games on Wednesdays. 5th-6th Grade practices will be held on Tuesday & will have games on Thursday.** Open to kids currently enrolled in 3-6. Please refer to the activity schedule for class times and options.

Activity Cost: \$25

Boys Basketball

This program will be held at the tennis courts (South of the Sheldon High School). Participants will meet two days a week, each week we'll be doing drills, learning technique and rules, playing supervised pickup games, and playing various games related to basketball. On the last day of Summer Rec. all participants will be in an All-Star contest in which they'll be participating in a skills challenge and free throw challenge. Open to kids currently enrolled in 3rd-6th grade. Please refer to the activity schedule for class times and options.

PROGRAM COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

Outdoor Activities

Golf

This program will be held at the Sheldon Golf Course. Participants will learn the basic fundamentals of the game of golf. Rules, etiquette and techniques of the game will be taught. Golf will be held two days a week and you can choose between Monday & Wednesday's and Tuesday & Thursday's. You do not need to have your own set of clubs to participate. Open to kids currently enrolled in 3-8. Please refer to the activity schedule on page 8 for class times and options.

Need 3 or more participants per class time

Activity Cost: \$25

Tennis / Pickle ball

This program will be held at the High School Tennis Courts. Participants will meet two days a week and the basic fundamentals of tennis will be introduced through drills and match play. Kids will also be introduced to pickle ball, which they will learn about the rules and the fundamentals of the game. Open to kids currently enrolled in 3rd-8th. Please refer to the activity schedule for class times and options.

Need 3 or more participants per class time

Activity Cost: \$25

CO-ED Soccer

This program will be held out at the Sheldon Sports Complex. Participants will meet two days a week and learn the basic fundamentals of soccer as well as the rules. Each day the participants meet they will have a 10-15 minute practice where they will learn dribbling, passing, and shooting skills. After practice they will then have a supervised game. This program is a CO-ED program and will have division for 5 years old (**must be 5 years old by June 4, 2018**)-Kindergarten, 1st-2nd Grade, 3rd-4th Grade, and 5th-6th Grade. Please refer to the activity schedule for class times and options.

Little Athletes

This program is open to boys and girls who will be 5 years old by the start date of June 4, 2018 or in Kindergarten. Little Athletes will cover a variety of sports, with each class incorporating a mixture of learning basic fundamentals with fun and challenging games! 3RD-6TH GRADE LITTLE LEAGUE BASEBALL & SOFTBALL PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS

We are excited to announce that we have formed a league with 5 other towns (Rock Valley, Sibley, Hull, Rock Rapids & Larchwood) to create a very balanced schedule for our little league this year. Each grade will be playing two games a week (1 home & 1 away) and will play on Tuesday & Thursday nights. Additional games may be added based on the number of participants. A complete schedule will be provided to you by your coach and will also be available online once the registration process is complete.

Volunteer Coaches: All volunteer coaches will receive a \$15 discount and will receive a free team t-shirt and hat. We will have a coaches meeting (date and time are TBD), in which we'll go over the game schedule, rules, and practices.

UNIFORMS: You will have the option to purchase a uniform top if needed. It is also recommended that you purchase black baseball/softball pants to complete your uniform. An additional uniform option for you is to purchase a baseball hat or softball visor for \$16. Also if you would like your last name on the back of your uniform top you can do that as well for an additional \$5. Both of these options will be made available for you when you register your child.

****We will be using the same jerseys as of last year (2017 season). If your son(s)/daughter(s) uniform still fits, you will not need to purchase a new jersey for the 2018 season.**

We supply the bait and equipment if you don't have any. There are a maximum number of 5 participants per session. During our time we'll be going to fishing holes within the O'Brien County. Open to kids currently enrolled in 3rd-8th Grade.

PRIVATE SWIMMING LESSONS:

On Wednesday, May 23 the Recreation Department will be accepting private swimming lessons to anyone who would want one. You must contact Jake Kerr at jkerr@cityofsheldon.com. He will provide a list of WSI Certified Lifeguards that you may contact. **NOTE: The Sheldon Recreation Department does not set the cost of private swimming lessons.**

PRESCHOOL LESSONS (AGES 3-5)

This lesson group gives young children ages 3-5 a positive, developmentally appropriate aquatic learning experience that emphasizes water safety and survival concepts. Skills are age-appropriate helping participants achieve success on a regular basis while in a class environment with their peers. Age is determined by age on the first day of class.

LEVEL 1 – FEEL COMFORTABLE IN THE WATER

- Helps participants feel comfortable in the water and to enjoy the water safely. Children will learn to enter and exit the water using the ladder, steps or side and start working on submerging in the water. They will learn to open eyes under water, retrieve submerged objects and begin learning to float.

LEVEL 2 – FUNDAMENTAL SKILLS

- Builds on the skills learned in level 1 and gives participants success with fundamental skills such as floating and basic locomotion.

LEVEL 3 – WATER COORDINATION

- Builds on the skills in Level 2 and improves participants' coordination of simultaneous arm and leg actions and alternating arm and leg actions.

PARENT AND CHILD AQUATICS

Ages 6 months – 3 years old

Builds basic water safety skills for both parents and children, helping infants and young children ages 6 months to 3 years become comfortable in the water so they are willing and ready to learn to swim. These basic skills include adjusting to the water environment, showing comfort while maintaining a front or back position in the water and demonstrating breath control, including blowing bubbles or voluntarily submerging under water. Age is determined by the age on the first day of class.

RED CROSS LEARN-TO-SWIM

Participants must be 5 years old or older on the 1st day of class

The Recreation Department will provide the American Red Cross Learn to Swim Program at the Sheldon Family Outdoor Aquatic Center. All swimming instructors are certified in First Aid, CPR, Lifeguard Training and/or Water Safety Instruction.

RED CROSS LEVELS

Level 1: Orientation to water for children who are uncomfortable putting their face in the water. Also for the child who cannot float without support on their back or front.

Level 2: Building on Basic Skills-Prerequisite: Child will put their face in the water and blow bubbles. Child is comfortable lying on their back or front with support

Level 3: Achieve Basic Water Competency-Prerequisite: Child has successfully passed level 2, or can front float for 10 seconds and back float for 15 seconds without support. Child is able to swim on front and back without support for 8 yards.

Level 4: Improve Proficiency and Learning All 6 Strokes-Prerequisite: Child has successfully passed level 3, or can front and back float for 30 seconds, swim front crawl, and elementary back stroke for 15 yards, and complete a kneeling head first entry in the deep end.

Level 5: Refining All 6 Swimming Strokes-Prerequisite: Child has successfully passed level 4; or can swim front crawl and elementary back crawl 25 yards and Breast stroke, Butterfly, Back stroke and Side stroke 15 yards.

Level 6: Refine Strokes and Introduce Self-Rescue Techniques-Prerequisite: Child has successfully passed level 5; or can swim front crawl and elementary back stroke 50 yards, tread water for 5 minutes and swim Breast stroke, Butterfly, Back Crawl, and Side stroke for 25 yards.
